Title	<b>Clarification of policy regarding booster parents who own a business</b>

Background Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thunder Board Policies and Procedures (Section 4.13) states that “An Officer or Booster Club Member who has or whose family has a substantial interest in any contract, sale, purchase or service to Thunder Board or any Booster Club shall be prohibited from voting or influencing decisions related to same.”</li> <li>• Some people have interpreted the above policy to mean that any booster club parent who owns or manages a business is prohibited from selling their products or services to the booster club, or at least must do so at zero profit (covering only their costs). This is not the intent of the policy.</li> <li>• Booster club officers or members who have such a business interest are asked to simply make it known and allow others to make all decisions related to purchases from their business.</li> <li>• The intent behind the conflict of interest policy is to avoid the situation where someone who might profit from selling products or services to the booster club is using inappropriate influence in the decision process.</li> </ul>
<b>Policy Statement</b>	<b>Booster club members who own or manage a business are allowed to sell products and services to the booster club and make a reasonable profit from the transaction. The policy on conflict of interest is intended to simply restrict such individuals from having a vote or undue influence on the decision to use their business.</b>
